Due to special arrangements made prior to the trip, the group was given a private tour of the concert hall and the playhouse. The professional guide explained the concept and history of the Center's design and construction. The final destination was the former British Consulate built in 1864, the oldest piece of western architecture in Taiwan still in existence. Climbing up to the Consulate located at the top of the hill was not so easy, but the magnificent views of Kaohsiung from the top were worth it! It was a wonderful ending to the trip!
