## Taiyuan Asian Puppet Theatre Museum 台原亞洲偶戲博物館







Dear members,

Taiyuan Asian Puppet Theatre Museum (formerly Lin Liu-Hsin Puppet Theatre Museum) is probably the most active and special puppet theater museum in the world. In 2000, the Taiyuan Art and Culture Foundation established TTT Puppet Centre together with its director: Dr. Robin Ruizendaal.

Dr. Robin Ruizendaal comes from Holland, he has been engaged in the study of puppet theatre for 20 years and can speak English, Mandarin and Taiwanese fluently. He has combined the traditional Taiwanese puppetry and modern theatre elements to start the choreography and performance of the puppet theatre. And he led the team to Europe, Latin America and other countries to perform and exchange.

The Art & Culture Group invites Director Robin to give us a speech about how he became attached to the puppet show and the development and vision of the puppetry. Welcome everyone to submit questions. After Q&A, a puppet show and a visiting tour will be followed.

Before the start of the event at the Puppet Museum, we will have lunch at the Tai-Chun Cuisine, which is highly recommended by Director Robin. The caterpillar
